

TEACHING LEARNING / CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT

TOTAL PROGRAMMES WITH CURRENT STUDENT AND FACULTY STRENGTH

During the session 19-20 a total of 60 programmes were conducted. The total students and faculty strength are given programme wise in table 1 in annexure. The eligibility criteria for every programme are given in table 2 and their detailed fees in table 3. A total of 78 faculty and 62 non teaching were recruited during the session and listed in table 4.

ACADEMIC MODEL AND EVALUATION

In every programme, the students were taught with BOS approved syllabus which constituted core technical subjects, Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses, Discipline/ generic Specific electives, Skill Enhancement Courses with Practical and tutorial classes. Sports was facilitated as a non credited compulsory course. The evaluation process was conducted in compliance to IIMTU ordinance and during covid period the guidelines of UGC and respective regulatory bodies of different programme were complied.

Student and Faculty Training

- 1. Student Training** - students of prefinal year of B.Tech. CSE, BCA & B.Sc. (CS) were offered training by Google in Associate Engineering Cloud Computing Course. Second year B.Tech. CSE students have been enrolled in Google cloud foundation course through National Programme on Technology Enhancement Learning.
- 2. Coursera** - Hundreds of students have done certification in International programs of coursera from hundreds of reputed worldwide University like Harvard, MIT and many more.
